

ROLE OF TEAM MANAGER

The following describes the role of team Manager as required under the rules of the Dalyellup Beach Football Club when playing Australian Rules Football under the South West Junior Football League by-laws.

The aim is to ensure Dalyellup Dockers Football Club players have fun and enjoy participating in the game by displaying the traits of fair-play and sportsmanship.

Things you must have:

- Scorecards, Team sheet book,
- DDFC players list including contacts, emergency contact numbers, medical conditions of each player,
- First Aid Kit,
- 1 x Game Football (Size 2 for 9's and 10 plus Size 3 for 11's and 12's),
- Field Insurance Forms,
- Drinks containers & Carry Crates,
- Whiteboard, Goal flags, Fluoro runners vest,
- Umpires payment (home games only - \$20)

People you must have;

- Coach and Assistant Coach,
- One Goal Umpire,
- One timekeeper (home games only, Stopwatch and Air-horn)
- Ground team (4 volunteers to help set up the goals at home games at least 30 minutes prior to the game)
- Orange's person (set a roster for volunteers to supply oranges at every game for breaks between quarters)
- Water person (set a roster for volunteers to fill and carry the drink bottles at breaks between quarters)

Game day actions;

1. Fill in player, coach, manager and goal umpire name onto team sheet prior to the game,
2. Greet opposing team manager and exchange team sheets
3. Collect score cards from control and return at end of game and return to central control area. When at home return to DDFC Committee.
4. Complete and sign Insurance Form.
5. Collect your game ball at end of game.
6. Enjoy the game.

The following describes the role of pre-game ground team as required under the rules of the Dalyellup Dockers Football Club when playing Australian Rules Football under the South West Junior Football League by-laws.

The aim is to ensure Dalyellup Dockers Football Club players have fun and enjoy participating in the game by displaying the traits of fair-play and sportsmanship.

Things you must do at home games:

1. Erect the gazebos for the DDFC teams.
2. Place the goal posts on the playing field.
3. Set the boundary markers.
4. Ensure goal square is clearly marked.
5. Ensure centre circle of field is marked.
6. Check the playing surface for rubbish, branches, and hazardous objects on playing surface.
7. Check air-horn and stopwatch
8. Enjoy the game
